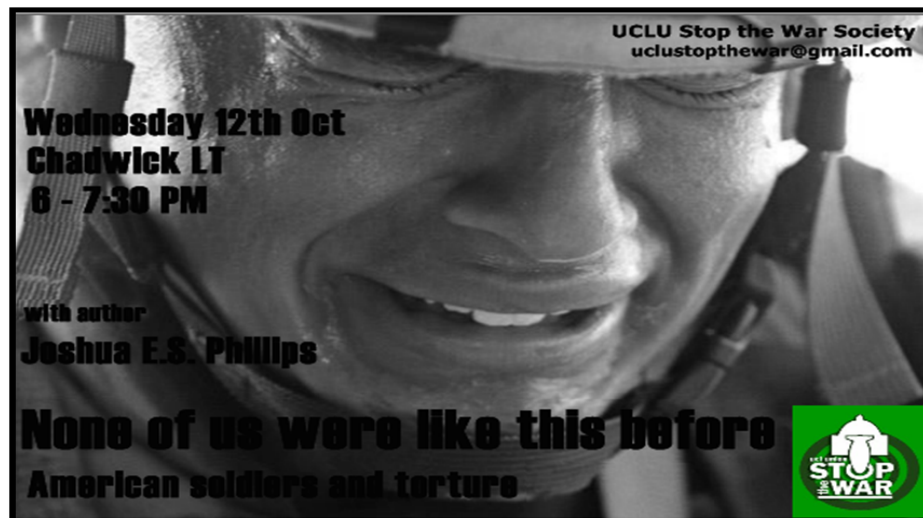




## ***None of Us Were Like This Before*** **American Soldiers and Torture**

On Wednesday, October 12th, American investigative journalist Joshua E.S. Phillips will be joining UCLU Stop the War for a discussion of his five-year investigation into American soldiers and torture.

Phillips has reported from much of Southern Asia as well as the Middle East. He has written for the Washington Post, Newsweek and The Nation, amongst others, and has broadcast radio features on the BBC and NPR. In 2006 he began investigating the story of Sergeant Adam Gray, who had survived his first tour of Iraq only to be found dead in his barracks just months after his return in 2004. Along the way he discovered the disturbing legacy of torture back home in the US as well as abroad in Afghanistan and Iraq.
